Ferenc Karoly, Esq. is the Executive Director of the Providence External Review Authority (PERA), a civilian oversight board for the Providence Police Department. The Board is responsible for investigating complaints of misconduct, reviewing, and recommending changes to department policies and procedures, and creating and implementing community outreach programs. He is the former Deputy Chief of the Middletown Police Department in Middletown, Rhode Island. As Deputy Chief, he oversaw the department's professional responsibility division and served as the main investigator while serving as the Administrative Services Lieutenant. His other law enforcement oversight experience includes previous roles as Patrol Lieutenant, and Prosecution Sergeant in Detectives. His prior responsibilities include service as a member of his department's Incident Response Team, Field Training Officer, certified crisis negotiator, Professional Standards investigator, Firearms Instructor, member of the Honor Guard, and past Union President.
