Bringing together more than **277** delegates from **>110** organisations, from across **7** states and territories and the UK

Delegates connected over two days of presentations including a poster session, conference dinner and field day to the Royal National Park.

NCC hosted 62 speakers who presented across 8 sessions, covering themes including climate change, community, Country, fauna and fire management. Ideas were shared from 32 organisations including at 6 sponsor stalls.
