

We engage in citizen science and media to let the world know what is happening in our forests and we invite our friends and community to join us and we call upon decision makers and opinion leaders to act urgently to protect our public native forests from logging

How to Join In

- 1. Join the Fridays4Forests Facebook Group
- 2. Invite your friends to do the same
- 3. Come along to Fridays4Forests gatherings in towns &/or forests near you (organise events for your local area if there isn't already an existing group)
- 4. Take photos and videos of yourself and your crew and share them on social media (follow the How To #StandUp4Forests instruction sheet)
- 5. Explore your forest and document its ecological values
- 6. Share knowledge on effective citizen science and citizen media techniques
- Write media releases, letters etc to the media and decision makers about your activities, what you have found and demand that our public native forests be protected permanently.
- 8. Invite everyone you know to join you.

Forests Survey Kit

In the forest - water, hat, phone, notebook or clipboard, hand lens (to look closely at the underside of leaves to help with ID) binoculars and diameter measuring tape optional.


Harvesting plans only go live 48 hours before logging or roading is due to commence. 5 Key documents, download as PDF as soon as you see them;
