Anna Lee Dillon Ordoubadi - CO-CHAIR & GPUS DELEGATE

Elected Co-Chair in December 2022, Anna has been active with the NCGP for over 10 years but did not join the CC until she stepped up as an interim Membership Chair and volunteer coordinator for the ballot access campaign in 2022. She first came to Green party politics when she worked on her father's campaign for Governor of Mississippi in 2003. She graduated from Jackson State University before getting a masters degree in social work from NCSU. Anna Lee is particularly interested in healthcare for all, rebuilding the anti-war/anti-imperialist movement and organizing for collective power in our communities. Anna Lee lives in Cary, NC with her partner and their three wonderful children.



Wayne Turner - CO-CHAIR

Elected at the Fall 2023 Gathering, Wayne has been serving as Assistant Treasurer and remains Chair of our Candidate Development and Endorsement Committee. Wayne has long served the NCGP in the past as Treasurer and was its first Co-Chair. In 2020, he helped to found the ranked choice voting non-profit Better Ballot NC, became its Treasurer and was the Lead of its Messaging Team. Wayne's background is in mathematics and engineering, and has worked in energy research and automation. He has extensive experience in working on legal and political issues related to ballot access for independent candidates and minor political parties. Wayne resides in Pittsboro and stays active with Triangle Greens Chapter, working for ballot access and assisting with many outreach events and candidate campaigns.



Frederick Clarkson - VICE-CHAIR

Fred began his NCGP support in 2017 associating with the Cape Fear chapter and in April 2020 became a dues-paying member. He began assisting the Coordinating Committee in March 2021 as a volunteer, was active in the ballot petitioning drive, and was elected NCGP Vice-Chair in December 2022. Ron Garcia-Fogarty – SECRETARY

Joining the NCGP in 2015, Ron has been a long-time dues-paying member, helping with its ballot access petitioning and candidate campaigns. Ron committed his life to working for social justice and democracy at an early age, by volunteering as part of the Nicaraguan Literacy Campaign in the 1980s, an experience that opened his eyes to realities other than his middle-class life. He is a national of Guatemala, Nicaragua, and the United States. He has worked for the rights of immigrants, farm workers, indigenous people, women, and for democracy and electoral reform, both in Nicaragua and the United States. In 2017 he co-founded Tilde Language Justice Cooperative, a cooperative that creates a sustainable

livelihood for language workers, and advances language justice by providing high-quality interpreting, translation, training, and consulting in the North Carolina Triangle region and beyond. In 2020 Ron was a Better Ballot NC Co-Founder, its first Executive Lead & President and Fundraising Team Lead. He has also been active with various political parties in Nicaragua and the US, and is currently a member of Unamos (Nicaragua), the Green Party, and Democratic Socialists of America.



Samantha Spence - ASSISTANT SECRETARY

Samantha joined the NCGP in March 2022 as a dues-paying supporter and active volunteer on the party's ballot petitioning drive, while also working tirelessly in several roles for the Matthew Hoh Senate campaign. She continues giving time to help build the NCGP and as a Green candidate campaign volunteer. Samantha is devoted to her family, and she and her partner reside in Stanfield.



Kalia Fitzgerald - MEMBERSHIP CHAIR & GPUS DELEGATE
