I work with USGBC-CA, AIA-LB/SB, BDC, CRP LA, CAC, CCL, and other groups on driving down demand for gas in buildings by replacing methane-fired appliances with electric ones affordably and equitably, primarily as they approach end of life. #ElectrifyEverything nerd. I'd encourage bold targets and actions for a balance of incentives and where necessary, mandates, aimed at ensuring when every gas appliance reaches end of life it is replaced with electric. Buildings are one of the most challenging aspects of the entire climate solutions puzzle, and cities have unique and outsized authority to act on buildings because of the Land Use Elements of our General Plans. I'll offer that USGBC-CA would be happy to help with policy design including reach codes, building performance standards, benchmarking, AC2HP, and more. One related critical point: the wildfire rebuild offers a unique opportunity to act not just at the scale of individual appliances and buildings, but entire neighborhoods. Instead of rebuilding in the same old way with both gas and electric, we should disallow SoCalGas from recapitalizing their distribution pipelines and build those neighborhoods all electric. There's little-known reason to emphasize this: gas pipelines are budgeted on 50 to 60-year expected lifetimes, at a typical cost of \$3~4M per mile. Yet we know we need to be using 90-100% less of their product in just 20 years, so we will be faced with a huge stranded asset problem. Thanks for your reply about the DBS actions!
