re: SB 79: The City's Housing Element (approved by the State) met all of the State's goals for housing in this housing cycle. Under the Housing Element, In many communities, with public input, development is to be focused on commercial corridors and via adaptive reuse. Some areas of single family homes were also upzoned to allow multi-family housing. Housing was being focused near transit with incentive programs for Transit Oriented Development. There is also hybrid use of industrial and light manufacturing land. SB 79 throws away much of the work of the Housing Element and of the community plans now in progress. SB 79 compliance is not optional. The City was given a short time frame to adopt it or a Local Alternative Plan which the Council is now considering. By having development determined by developers, speculators, REITs, etc. and scattered all over the R1 zones now opened up for development by SB 79, there is no way for the City to plan an efficient way to deliver public services and infrastructure. We zone to target where development should be placed and to allow for the infrastructure to support it. Feldstein Soto's letter of opposition sent to the State legislature when they were considering SB 79, went into all the fiscal impacts that SB 79 will have on the City. I urge all to read it. That is why she opposed it. The City Council voted to oppose it as well. It is seen as another State effort that undermines local government authority over land use. Even Metro is realizing that measures such
