Sunday, October 9—conversation with candidates about CD 15 and democracy vouchers

Join us for a conversation about Council District 15, which includes Harbor City, Harbor Gateway, San Pedro, Watts, Wilmington, and the Port of Los Angeles. City council candidate **Danielle Sandoval** and California State Assembly District 65 candidate **Fatima Iqbal-Zubair** (whose district would include most of CD 15) will talk with us about the needs of the district and their visions for it and beyond, with a focus on sustainability. Bring your comments and questions!

We will also talk with the candidates and <u>Los Angeles for Democracy</u> <u>Vouchers</u> about campaign finance reform and the democracy-voucher model, which our representatives will vote on.

We expect a third draft from City Planning in the coming weeks. It's not too late to submit a community impact statement!

LA Zoo Alternative 1.5
