

In Lincoln, the Aldersgate United
Methodist Church won IPL's Cool
Congregations Challenge Sacred
Grounds award for transforming a 1.9
acre lawn surrounding the
congregation into a neighborhood
park and arboretum. This features a
landscaping plan that benefits the
environment and serves the
community by providing habitat for
wildlife, immersion in nature, and
nature-based play for children.



Due to Covid, the project eligibility window has been expanded again for 2023. Projects completed in 2020, 2021, and 2022 will be eligible to apply. Deadline Dec 15, 2022, awards announced in February 2023.

Nebraska IPL will be offering a \$100 incentive for each congregation that applies to be part of the contest.
