

END ICE ABUSE NOW – STAND UP FOR OUR RIGHTS, CONSTITUTION AND HUMANITY

Dear Congressman Tom Kean Jr., Jeff Van Drew, and Chris Smith:

We, the undersigned organizations and individuals urge you to speak out publicly for Congressional adoption of policies and actions that end the systemic abuses of law and violations of the U.S. Constitution perpetrated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP). As federal agencies within the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), these entities must be held to the same legal standards, oversight, and accountability requirements as all other law enforcement agencies nationwide.

The current pattern of mass detentions and deportations is inhumane and reflects a profound failure of leadership. These actions stem from years of political neglect and the refusal to pursue a sensible, lawful, and humane immigration system. We urge you to act swiftly to advance a fair, humane, and accessible pathway to citizenship that upholds the rule of law, human rights, and our democratic values. Communities across New Jersey and the nation are living in fear as a result of unchecked enforcement practices, lack of oversight, and repeated violations of civil and constitutional rights.

This crisis is urgent in New Jersey. Immigrants make up nearly one-quarter of New Jersey's population and are deeply embedded in the state's economic and social fabric. They are essential workers, small-business owners, caregivers, health professionals, construction workers, and taxpayers who contribute billions of dollars annually to New Jersey's economy. Policies that criminalize and destabilize immigrant communities do not make our state safer, they weaken families, harm local economies, and undermine public trust.

We urge you to act swiftly to advance a fair, humane, and accessible pathway to citizenship that upholds due process, human rights, and democratic values. The United States is a nation of immigrants, and all people within our borders are protected by the U.S. Constitution. Everyone — regardless of immigration status — has the right to due process under the law.

We further call on Congress to withhold any additional funding for ICE and CBP until meaningful reforms are enacted. The dramatic expansion of immigration enforcement funding in recent years has occurred without corresponding safeguards or accountability. ICE's budget has grown from approximately \$9.5 billion in FY 2024 and prior years to roughly \$78 billion under current

proposals — an increase of more than 721%. This unprecedented expansion has come at the direct expense of vital public programs.

At a minimum, Congress must reverse this massive increase in enforcement funding and restore resources to essential services that were cut or weakened, including Medicaid and enhanced Affordable Care Act subsidies, which support the health and economic stability of millions of families nationwide.

Additionally, the expansion of detention facilities must be halted until the reforms outlined below are fully implemented. Existing facilities are plagued by unsafe and inhuman conditions that amount to a humanitarian crisis. At a minimum, all facilities must comply with state and local health, safety, and building standards.

We urge you to join us in publicly supporting the reforms listed below and to issue a public statement outlining your support for them. These reforms are essential to ensuring that immigration enforcement is lawful, humane, and consistent with the U.S. Constitution:

- **Require judicial warrants and due process protections:** End indiscriminate arrests, require and enforce judicial warrants, and mandate verification of legal status before holding people in immigration detention.
- **Protect lawful pathways:** End deportations of individuals who are actively following legal processes toward lawful status or citizenship.
- **No masks during enforcement:** Prohibit ICE and immigration enforcement agents from wearing face coverings during enforcement operations.
- **Clear identification requirements:** Require DHS officers to visibly and accurately display their agency affiliation, unique ID number, and last name, and verbally provide this information upon request.
- **Protect sensitive locations:** Prohibit enforcement actions near sensitive locations, including medical facilities, schools, child-care facilities, houses of worship, polling places, courts, etc.
- **End racial profiling:** Prohibit stops, questioning, searches, or arrests based race, ethnicity, language, accent, occupation, or presence at particular locations.
- **Uphold use of force standards:** Codify strict use of force standards, expand training and certification requirements, and require officers involved in use of force incidents to be removed from the field pending investigation.

- **Ensure state and local coordination and oversight:** Preserve the ability of state and local governments to investigate and prosecute potential crimes and use of excessive force incidents by DHS agents. Require preservation and sharing of evidence and state and local consent for large-scale operations.
- **Build safeguards into detention systems:** Require all detention facilities to meet uniform detention standards, including immediate access to legal counsel. Allow states to sue DHS for violations and prohibit restrictions on congressional visits to detention facilities.
- **Body cameras for accountability, not surveillance:** Require body-worn cameras during public interactions, mandate clear requirements for footage storage and access, and prohibit the use of such footage for tracking or databases related to First Amendment-protected activities.
- **End paramilitary-style enforcement:** Regulate and standardize uniforms and equipment used by DHS officers to align with civil enforcement norms.
- **Remove Krisiti Noem** as the head of the Department of Homeland Security. She has failed to ensure federal agents are following laws and has allowed their lawless behavior to run rampant, which has led to the murdering of American citizens at the hands of ICE agents.
- **Prohibit arrest and deportation quotas and financial incentives tied to enforcement numbers.**
- **Protect immigrants with Temporary Protected Status (TPS):** Support legislative action to extend TPS for Haitian nationals and others currently living in the U.S. under TPS.
- **Ban individuals with felony convictions,** including those later pardoned, from employment with ICE or CBP.
- **Restore funding for healthcare and other essential services** that were cut and redirected to immigration enforcement in recent federal legislation.
- **Ensure accountability through the courts:** Establish a clear right for individuals to sue federal agents for constitutional violations and require independent investigations that include state and local authorities.
- **Advance a comprehensive and inclusive pathway to citizenship** for all immigrants currently living in the United States.

We look forward to hearing back from you and receiving your public statements regarding these reforms which are good and necessary to ensuring our immigrant enforcement is humane and lawful. What has played out in our nation has been un-American and shameful. We urge you to

do all you can to put a stop to it immediately as lives and our nation's values and reputation are on the line every day that goes by without these reforms enacted.
