Methane emissions intensity dropped over 50% in the Permian Basin between 2022 and 2024, thanks to AI-driven monitoring and upgraded equipment.

Over 113,000 tons of CO₂-equivalent emissions reduced through partnerships with regulators and Tribal governments.



Water conservation efforts include using recycled and brackish water, closed-loop systems, and on-site recycling.

Land restoration projects exceed state and federal standards, protecting wildlife and revitalizing ecosystems.
