Patrol Unit

The mission of the Patrol Unit is to protect life and property in Multnomah County, and to enforce the Oregon Criminal Code and Multnomah County Ordinances. Thirty-two patrol deputies are responsible for providing 24-hour a day law enforcement services to unincorporated Multnomah County, Maywood Park and Wood Village. Deputies serve a residential population of about 16,500, plus approximately 3 million visitors per year to the Columbia Gorge Scenic area and Sauvie Island recreational areas. The workload is increasing due to more community involvement and problem solving. Patrol area map
