
My policy priorities follow hundreds of conversations with people across our electorate and truly represent the ambitions I have repeatedly heard.

POLICY PRIORITIES

Since announcing my candidacy as the Independent for the Federal seat of North Sydney in September 2021, my team and I have literally had hundreds of conversations with people right across our electorate – including those with qualified expertise, members of advocacy and policy groups, and discussions with local residents.

What is clear is the people of North Sydney want politics done differently.

We want our voice and our vote to matter, and for the things we stand for to be truly reflected by our Federal government.

We must move beyond the old-fashioned two-party system where collaboration and consensus building are no longer valued or pursued.

Ultimately, these policies represent what the people of North Sydney wish to see advocated for at the federal level and it would be my great honour to be that voice for our community.



URGENT CLIMATE ACTION LED BY FACTS, NOT POLITICS



This is the critical decade for climate action and the decisions made in the next three years will fundamentally affect our children's and their children's future

I will support:

- Removing the politics from the climate debate by introducing an independent climate change body to develop an evidence-based plan to achieve net zero by 2040.
- A clear and actionable plan to reduce national emissions by at least 50% by 2030.
- Making the Federal seat of North Sydney one of the first Net Zero Energy Urban Zones in Australia, as we transition to a fully electrified community.
- Improved fuel emission standards and initiatives that increase the rate of adoption of electric vehicles across Australia.
- The gradual and planned removal of subsidies for coal and gas, with no new coal and gas extraction projects.
- Protecting our green corridors and ensuring any new infrastructure projects provide solutions for the next century, including:
 - » demanding transparency from the Prime Minister on commitments related to the Western Harbour Tunnel and Northern Beaches Link.
 - » calling for a suspension of any further work until key stakeholders (including local councils and resident groups) are satisfied that all alternatives have been fully explored and concerns fully addressed and mitigated.





A FORWARDFOCUSED ECONOMY

It's not enough to be the lucky country
– we have to be smart as well

I will support:

- A detailed plan which maps the decarbonisation of the Australian economy and prioritises reskilling, and greater support for tertiary education skills development.
- Investment in high growth, innovative green industries to enable economic growth as we transition to a net zero carbon economy.
- The development of a clean R&D and manufacturing corridor from North Sydney to Macquarie Park, with greater investment in R&D and start-up incentives and support, as well as prioritised skilled migration to drive productivity, innovation and economic growth.
- A focus on modernising industry which incentivises the production of green products (such as green steel, green aluminium and green hydrogen) and provides a transition fund to support communities.
- A sustainable recovery plan from COVID-19 for small business.

INTEGRITY IN FEDERAL POLITICS



Restore integrity to politics by tackling corruption, dishonesty and discrimination

I will support:

- A truly independent, well-resourced Australian Federal Integrity Commission with teeth, like that advocated for in Helen Haines' Integrity Bills.
- Legislative reform to ensure truth in political advertising and curtail the influence of money in politics, prioritising real-time donation reporting.
- Better budget oversight to stop "pork barrelling" and the waste and mismanagement of public funds.

EQUALITY AND RESPECT



Everyone deserves respect and a fair go, no matter their background

I will support:

- Greater support for families, with equal rights for parents to access paid parental leave and universal access to early childhood education and care.
- Developing programs to prevent violence and discrimination against women, including specific measures to reduce the gender pay gap and improve superannuation outcomes for women in Australia, and the implementation of all 55 recommendations from the Respect@Work Report.
- A reconciled Australia, with a true First Nation's voice enshrined in our Constitution.
- The immediate release of all refugees held in indefinite detention in Australia.

HEALTHY FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES



A holistic coordinated vision for Australian families which supports communities across a lifetime, and reforms and recharges our health services

I will support:

- Funding of quality public education and increased support for post-high school education, training, and research.
- An immediate "Interim Review" of our experiences during COVID to enable better planning and greater preparedness, including the release of final recommendations on the Medicare Item number review.
- A coordinated response to identify and address the underlying systemic issues driving unprecedented mental health distress.
- Revitalising and increasing our health and aged care workforce.
- Establishing a National Centre for Disease Control and Prevention, including the roll-out of a National Preventive Health Strategy.
