Student Opinion is promoted via the NUS TOTUM database


A prize draw of £150 is offered to encourage responses.

Support of strike action




The gender pay gap and cut pensions are the potential strike issues students are most commonly aware of

Key demographics & characteristics

1621 students and learners completed the survey

33% of participants have a disability, impairment or long-term health condition

86% study in England

62% of respondents are under 30

20% are international students

56% of students are women, **39%** are men and **3%** are non-binary

36% are in FE and **64%** are HE students
