



2024 Highlights

What we've won

\$3.3 million for mental health services to address racial, language, cultural, & income disparities in mental health access.

Our 2022-2023 win with El Futuro was so successful, the funding was doubled! Then the NC Dept. of Health & Human Services adopted the program as a statewide model for all groups facing barriers to care.

\$850,000+ to preserve existing affordable housing For low-income homeowners to keep their homes, via a property tax relief program that's the strongest in the state. Originally ARPA-funded, it became sustainably funded by the County's general budget in 2024!

Reentry Housing
Launch of Orange County and Alliance Health's formal search for property and funds for housing people leaving incarceration, institutional settings, and/or homelessness.

Healthcare Access
Medicaid enrollment sessions in rural Orange County + UNC Hospital's Director of Financial Assistance working with us to remove barriers facing uninsured/underinsured patients.

What's next

Healthcare Access
We're running a community-led evaluation of the barriers for accessing UNC Hospital's financial assistance program. Members whose applications were initially rejected are working together to get their applications approved and assess specific areas for improving the process, to propose to the Financial Assistance Director.

Immigrant Rights
We're creating an organizing strategy centered on immigrant rights and leadership. We're organizing teams to prioritize resources and actions and to grow as leaders.

Home Repairs
We're organizing to close a \$2 million gap in needed funds so that low-income households can stay safely in their homes.

Statewide Action
After joining our NC affiliate groups, 1,200-strong, to win commitments from our Governor, Attorney General, and Superintendent of Public Instruction – we will organize to ensure follow-through! Commitments include affordable housing, mental health, education, immigrant rights, and food security.
