On Tuesday April 16th the Federal Energy Regulation Commission released their decision approving the expansion of the GTN XPress Pipeline, despite a strong vote of descent from Commissioner Allison Clements who stated that there is strong evidence that the project is not needed. Oregon PSR and our partners have been working tirelessly to fight the expansion of the GTN Pipeline and are deeply disappointed by the FERC's decision.

We will continue working with partners to challenge the GTN Xpress Pipeline expansion and keep you informed on ways to support.
