1. Meeting called to order at 4:34
 - a. 8/21 RA Minutes approved unanimously
 - b. Agenda unanimously approved with flexibility.

2. President's Report: Angela Bonilla
 - a. Reviewed status of Evergreen and Camas educators strike
 - b. Reviewed upcoming community events and shared that PTA Community Organizer Joanne Sheppard will present on PTA action
 - c. Reviewed 8/30 Executive Board meeting and approved actions.
 - i. Executive Board Meeting Summaries are available to members
 - d. Reviewed great labor work being done by building reps in filing grievances, CAT leads and rep organizing committees.

3. Community Organizer Report: Joanne Sheppard
 - a. Shared options for reps and members to join the CAT team and engage with PAT supporting community partners. 80+ volunteers already signed up to support- flyer elementary schools. Lawn and business signs will also be delivered.
 - b. Shared upcoming online Skills to Win labor training through UC Berkeley. Reps were encouraged to sign up and attend! Held over the next six Wednesdays.

4. Vice-President's Report: Jacque Dixon
 - a. Shared the news that over 75 schools have reported their rep election results!
 - b. Members are asked to make sure to report their results using the shared form if not already done so.
 - c. Shared E-Board zone directors and encouraged reps to reach out for help as needed.
 - d. Uniserv Rep Kristine Mayle shared CAT team structure, contact information for captains and encouraged reps to join. Shared the importance of having reps share campaign data with their CAT lead/zone director.

5. Bargaining Update: Steve Lancaster
 - a. Shared that 11 items have been agreed to (all either maintaining or improvements from last contract)
 - b. District has yet to respond with proposals on core issues for PAT. No new proposals since March on what the district is required to bargain over
 - c. Over 60 days now working without a contract. PAT is refusing to bargain over multiple issues including class size
 - d. Angela Bonilla reviewed bargaining timeline, goals and upcoming dates. Reps encouraged to continue their 1 on 1 conversations, wear their working without a contract button and reach out for support.

6. Treasurer's Report: Tina Lamanna
 - a. Reviewed strike updates. OEA strike fund would distribute approximately \$120 per day per member. NEA will offer interest free loans while additional resources from OEA and other groups will be available.

7. OEA Vice-President's Comments: Enrique Farrera
 - a. Shared updates across the state and experiences of other locals. PAT is a model on how to build up. OEA is looking to change it's structure to better empower members.

8. Rep Grievance Training: Shauna Wheeler
 - a. Shared experiences and best practices in grievance filing.
 - b. Reps then went through a training on grievance filing related to plans of assistance.
