Is my schedule fair and does it allow me to support my students?

Use this checklist to review your PAT/PPS contract rights – Article 7.

Is my standard workday 7 hours and 45 minutes? (8 hrs. for Specific Specialists*)	YES	NO
Does my workday begin at least 15 minutes before the student day?	YES	NO
If I am required to perform duty during those 15 minutes, is it 7.5 minutes or less?	YES	NO
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Do I have 30 continuous minutes of duty free lunch daily ?	YES	NO
<i>(Those 30 minutes should not include any time during which I supervise students, e.g., monitoring lunchroom, escorting students, etc.).</i>

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<i>The contract says I may be required on 30 designated Tuesdays to attend meetings or training sessions for up to 90 minutes beyond the workday, starting at the beginning of the end-of-day 15 minute planning period. If other meetings beyond the workday are required, attendance is voluntary on my part and must be paid.</i>		
Do I have to attend only one weekly meeting, up to 90 minutes, beyond the workday?	YES	NO
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Does my workday extend at least 15 minutes beyond the student day?	YES	NO
