1. Meeting called to order at 5:02 p.m.
2. **Motion:** 4/30/25 Minutes and 6/04 agenda approved by acclamation
3. **President's Report:**
 - a. President Bonilla reviewed a recent meeting with the PPS HR chief, Dr. Freeman . An update was provided on budget cuts, unassignments, layoffs and the lack of responsiveness from the district.
 - i. Question: I have someone at my site assigned to another school .2 but wants only the .1 they are owed. What will happen?
 1. Answer: Priority is to assign FTE based on what is owed.
