



SAFEGUARDING OUR SCHOOLS



AS A UNION OF EDUCATORS, **WE RISE UP TO PROTECT OUR STUDENTS & COMMUNITIES FROM IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT (ICE) VIOLENCE.**

In light of the increasing presence of ICE in our communities - and especially within close proximity to schools - OEA Members reaffirm our commitment to safe school policies, protecting student privacy, and connecting families to support. Follow these three steps if you witness ICE officers in your community or near your school or worksite:

1. **REMAIN CALM.**

- * Take a Deep Breath.
- * Feel your feet on the ground.

2. **REPORT ACTIVITY.**

Report ICE activity to the **Portland Immigration Rights Coalition** hotline at
1-888-622-1510.

If you have recorded video of the ICE activity, PIRC may request a copy of your footage.

3. **RIGHT TO FILM.**

If you feel comfortable, record what you witness with your phone. You have the legal right to do so as long as you do not interfere.

Continuous video is best, and keep your filming **CLEAR**:

- Count** (3 officers, 1 van)
- Location** (SE 2nd and Morrison)
- Equipment** (Wearing blue, van)
- Activity** (Officers checking ID's)
- Report Time** (2:43pm Thursday)
