Meeting Called to order at: 5:06

1. **Meeting Agenda and 11/19/25 RA meeting minutes** approved by acclimation.
2. President Bonilla led a review of the PAT RA standing rules.
3. Members reviewed the procedure for candidate speeches at tonight's RA and elections timeline for the 2026 elections for PAT officers, board directors along with NEA and OEA delegates. Officers and board directors serve two year terms, OEA delegates are elected for three year terms and NEA delegates serve for a single term.

5. **Candidate Speeches:**
 - a. Candidates for PAT officer, board director, OEA and NEA delegate positions delivered speeches. Speeches were recorded and will be shared with members electronically.

 - c. Presented an overview of the data from the most recent all-member survey. Copies of the results will be shared with representatives as a part of the information sent out for their next building meeting.
 - d. Discussed Met with David Backer to help review PPS funding info through bond disclosures
 - e. Working on finalizing an MOU for PPS between PAT and PFSP to fund notary support for student release plans in case of ICE

7. Treasurer's Report:

- a. Tina Lamanna reviewed the monthly financial reports of the local. Treasurer Lamanna shared that the annual financial report is nearing completion and will be shared at an upcoming meeting.

8. Vice-President's Report:

- a. Vice-President Chavez led the RA in a moment of silence in recognition of Renee Nicole Good who was killed by ICE agents in Minneapolis earlier today.
- b. Alisha Chavez also led the RA in recognition of the work being done by PAT educators across the district including those at Marysville who led a successful advocacy campaign to receive an additional FTE.
