

TIMELINE FOR YOUR COMMITTEE PERSON CAMPAIGN

March 31	Ballots are set! And your campaign begins
Month of April	PERSUASION! Spend 10 hours in April talking to voters and earning their votes. Do this by knocking doors, hosting a block party, or doing a cleanup
Early April	Send Thank You notes to the voters who signed your petitions
April 2	Philly Spring Cleanup: Join an event and bring lit to share with voters
Mid-April	Mail ballots start arriving. Ask the person who recruited you for a list of voters who requested mail ballots. Talk to those voters about voting for you, and encourage them to return their ballots before the deadline
Month of May	GET OUT THE VOTE! GOTV is when you solidify support among your voters, and make sure they have a plan to vote, either by mail or in-person
May 7-14	Love Your Park Week: Join a cleanup and bring lit to share with voters
May 17, pt. 1	Election Day: Plan to spend the entire day (7am-8pm) at the polling place, to talk to voters and share your lit as they walk in. When things are slow, text or call your voters who haven't showed up yet to remind them to vote
May 17, pt. 2	Mail Ballot Deadline: Ballots must be received by (not postmarked by) 8pm
June 6	Ward Reorganization Meeting: You MUST be in attendance to vote for ward leadership! There are no proxy votes and the meeting is held at night
