## HEALTH

**Vascular:** Plaid Cymru fought hard to keep the excellent vascular unit at Ysbyty Gwynedd. Relocating the unit was a mistake. Siân is pressing for improvement. We must stop services moving from Bangor.

**Dental Services:** The lack of NHS dental services provision in Arfon is serious. Siân has raised the issue on the floor of the Senedd and we very much hope that the Dental Academy in Bangor that Siân campaigned for will go some of the way in solving the issue.

**Mother and Baby Unit:** Siân has called for the establishment of a mother and baby unit in north Wales to provide specialist perinatal mental health care for families.

**Hergest Unit:** The results of the Holden report are cause for great concern, and Plaid Cymru is calling for

transparency, accountability and improvement as a result of its publication.

**Health in Arfon:** There is cause to celebrate developments that Plaid Cymru have campaigned for as an increasing number of prospective doctors are being trained at Bangor Medical School. A new £38 million health and wellbeing centre is coming to Dyfryn Nantlle also.



## HOMES

**New Homes:** During the past year, Siân and Hywel have visited a number of new house building projects in Penygroes, Dinas, Bethesda and Bangor. These developments are desperately needed in light of the current housing crisis.

**Arbed:** The office continues to provide support to constituents who are having difficulties with the Welsh Government's Arbed scheme.

## COST OF LIVING

The cost-of-living crisis, fuelled by soaring inflation, rising interest rates and an uncontrollable hike in energy bills is already being felt across communities in Arfon. From families struggling to put food on the table, to small businesses facing financial ruin – without immediate intervention from government – a very grim winter lies ahead.

Plaid Cymru has repeatedly called on the UK government to take decisive action – to protect our most vulnerable households, to shelter small businesses and charities from unsustainable costs and above all else, to slash energy bills now.

The absence of an energy price cap for businesses for example means that the big energy firms are exploiting small businesses to breaking point.



## THE CO-OPERATION AGREEMENT



**Free School Meals:** This September we saw the culmination of months of work by Plaid Cymru and the Welsh Government as all pupils in the younger years of primary schools in Wales were given free school meals for the first time.

**A Flying Start:** From September, work has begun to expand the provision for the early years through the Flying Start programme. This provision includes free part-time care for 2-year-olds.

**Second Homes:** The Co-operation Agreement between

Plaid Cymru and the Welsh Government has ensured meaningful action on the second homes crisis. Tackling the crisis which is having a detrimental effect on communities across Arfon is a priority for Plaid Cymru.

**Family Farms:** Plaid Cymru has succeeded to force the Welsh Government to change course by implementing the **Water Resources Regulations (Manage Agricultural Pollution) (Wales) 2021** which replaced NVZ regulations.
