Smoke detectors & alarm systems

- If there is a fire, leave the building immediately using the nearest EXIT.
 - If SMOKE blocks the nearest exit, go to a second EXIT. If you can't exit the building, close your unit door and go to a window or balcony.
- If the smoke detector in your unit alarms, check for smoke or fire in your unit.
 - If the detector beeps intermittently, the battery may need to be replaced.
- If the building alarm system makes a loud noise, evacuate the building. **Call 911.**
- If there is a small fire and you feel safe doing so, find the nearest fire extinguisher to extinguish the fire. Use the PASS method. Call 911.
 - Pull the pin
 - Aim the nozzle at the base of the fire
 - Squeeze the handle
 - Sweep across the base of the fire
- If smoke is obscuring your vision never stay to fight a fire. Evacuate immediately.

Fire extinguishers are located on each landing and breezeway.

Fire Code requires that each unit have smoke detectors and Carbon Monoxide detectors. Smoke detectors must be replaced every 10 years and Carbon Monoxide must be replaced every 7 to 10 years as recommended by the manufacturer.

Cooking

- ALWAYS stay near the stove or oven when cooking
- Turn handles in so they don't get bumped and spill hot food or liquid
- Have a lid nearby in case of a flare-up
- Keep the stove and oven clean to reduce the chance of a grease fire

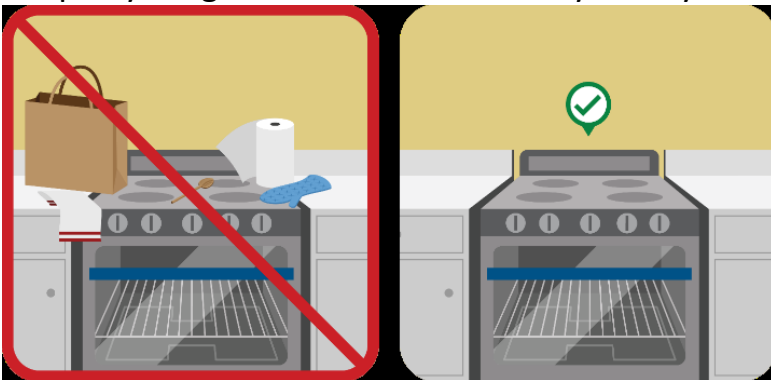
Stay in the kitchen when cooking – Keep an eye on what you fry!



Turn pot handles to the back - Use a lid to cover the pan



Keep anything that can catch fire away from your stovetop – including loose clothing



Grilling

- Charcoal grills are not allowed on decks or balconies.
- Keep propane grills clean and in good working order. Stay near the grill while cooling. Always shut them off immediately after you finish grilling.

Smoking

No smoking is permitted within 25 feet of a building.
