Project Respect is a support and referral service for women with diverse experiences in the sex industry.

We are an intersectional feminist, non-faith based, community not-for-profit organisation based in Melbourne, Victoria.

We have staff, volunteers and students in our team with experience in the sex industry.

We are informed by our peer led Women's Advisory Group.



our **services**

All of our services are *non-judgemental, confidential, free, private* and *do not require a referral*.

Project Respect services include:

- Telephone-based support, with free interpreting services as required
- Information and ongoing holistic support
- Referrals to other organisations to **achieve your goals**
- Safety planning to help you work safer
- Support to reduce hours or move away from the industry if this is your choice
- Intensive support for women who have experienced trafficking (both international and domestic)
- A friendly, knowledgeable woman to support and listen to you
- Advocacy for your rights
- Access to peer community lunches and relaxing community gardening sessions
- Flexible student placement opportunities
- Volunteer opportunities including with our Women's Advisory Group

who we're **for**

Our support is available to anyone in Australia who self-identifies as a woman (aged 18 and over), including all LGBTQIA+ women as well as gender diverse and non-binary people, inclusive of:

- Lived experience in any area of the sex and adult entertainment industry, licensed and unlicensed, online and in-person
- Experiences of trafficking for sexual exploitation (both international and domestic)
- Current or past involvement in the sex and adult entertainment industry
- Wanting to remain, increase or reduce hours in the sex industry
- Diverse views and experiences of the sex industry
- All immigration, visa, residency or citizenship status
- Relatives, friends and service providers who are seeking information or support about the sex industry
