Job Title: Research Officer (1 positions)

Summary:

We are seeking one (1) Research Officer, to support, facilitate and maintain healthy partner relationships with our community partners. The two areas that the Research Officer will focus on include,

- Primary: Building the organizational capacity of ProudPolitics Canada through business development activities.
- Secondary: Enhancing outreach to and gaining a better understanding of the needs, barriers, and opportunities of our core constituents: under-represented 2SLGBTQ+ candidates and leaders through research projects.

Responsibilities:

- Using business and non-profit acumen, build internal organizational capacity through various activities, such as researching and preparing grant applications and providing recommendations for a path towards charitable status in Canada.
- Identify and research grant opportunities that ProudPolitics is eligible for
- Support the ProudPolitics team to develop, prepare, and implement an engagement strategy (e.g., events, online campaigns) and plans for the upcoming 2022 Ontario Provincial Election and 2022 Municipal Elections.
- Fostering and maintaining networks to build capacity and collaboration
- Keeping well-informed on leadership commitments and priorities
- Determining logistical details and activities for events and/or programming
- Developing and implementing community engagement strategies and plans

Requirements:

- Strong desire to learn, while exhibiting a professional drive
- A passion for community and civic engagement and partnerships development (either through, professional experience or volunteer experience)
- Have interest and knowledge of Canadian politics and current affairs
- Have lived experience or knowledge of 2SLGBTQ+ communities and politics is a plus
- Strong computer skills with proficiency in MS Office programs, Google Suite, & Social Media platforms
- Good oral and written communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills
- Ability to meet deadlines and thrive in a fast-paced, flexible working environment
- Ability to work both independently and within a team environment
- Fundraising and grant development experience is a plus
- Knowledge and experience in a non-profit environment is a plus.
