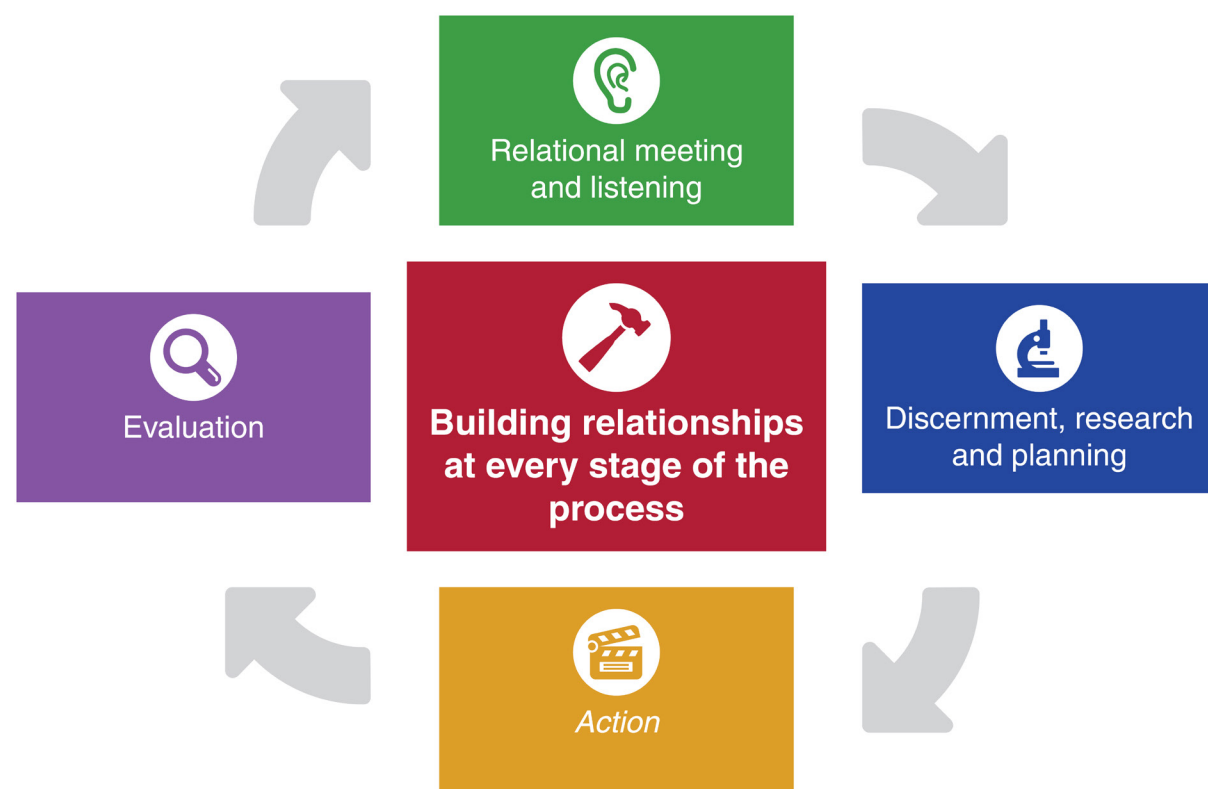

SINCE COMING TOGETHER OUR TOP WINS INCLUDE:

- \$2 billion Queensland Renewable Energy and Hydrogen Jobs Fund.
- World leading social prescribing network to address loneliness and social isolation in Mt Gravatt area. Now expanding to a state-wide strategy committed by Qld Government.
- Historic increase in funding for Neighbourhood Community Centres - \$125.6 million package over 4 years.
- Reducing missed ante-natal care in Logan by 67% through establishment of 5 Community Maternity Hubs.
- Workplace rights education program introduced for vulnerable migrant workers.
- New car park at Prince Charles Hospital will be publicly funded and built.
- Labour Hire Inspectors introduced to expose exploitative employment practices for Qld's most vulnerable workers.
