Dear Director Joseph Martino and the Hon. Doug Downey;

I am writing today to provide video evidence taken on February 18th, 2022 at the protest in Ottawa. We have heard reports from the Ottawa Police that those who were injured by their actions were able to get up and leave of their own volition, however that does not appear to be the case.

Linked in this letter is a video originally aired by TVA French language news that was recorded on TikTok that now appears to be removed on both platforms. The video shows a protester who appears to be severely injured, and contrary to the police's assertion, was unable to walk away on their own and was instead dragged from the gathering by what appears to be police.

In the interest of accountability and justice, it must be revealed what has happened to this individual and the situation surrounding this injury.

As this evidence directly contradicts the statements by the Chief of Ottawa Police Steve Bell, an urgent and prompt reply is required.
