In November, we were back on Zoom and talked through the pending California results (California takes a while to thoroughly count all of its ballots) including the positive results (we retained the Senate and did not get a shellacking in the House) and the negative (the Republicans will take control of the House and we were unable to flip the IE Blue--for some of us, insurrectionist Jay Obernolte is now our Congressional Representative). We also discussed the upcoming Assembly District Election Meetings or ADEMS and how they are another means of gaining a local voice in the California State Democratic Party.

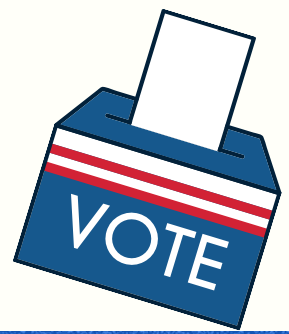

November Midterms



Unfortunately, Derek Marshall did not win his race for CA-23, but he made a definite impact and intends to build on the infrastructure he created this time and run again in 2024. Stay tuned for ways you can join his campaign beginning in 2023. We need to get Dems to return their ballots here in San Bernardino County! We can do this!

Pete Aguilar has won re-election, this time to a new edistrict (CA-31). He is also now #3 in the Dem Party in the House of Representatives!

Eloise Gomez-Reyes has been re-elected to California State Assembly District 50. She has announced that she is considering running for the California State Senate in the next election.

Helen Tran won the mayoral race in San Bernardino! This is a huge win for that city. Thank you, Redlands Dems, for supporting her campaign and the well-being of our neighboring city.

Nathan Gonzales has won election to the Board of the San Bernardino Community College District. He had previously been elected to that seat by the members of the Board for one year to complete a vacated seat.

Redlands City Council: Denise Davis has been re-elected to District 1, Mario Saucedo has been elected to District 3, and Paul Barich has been re-elected to the reconfigured District 5.

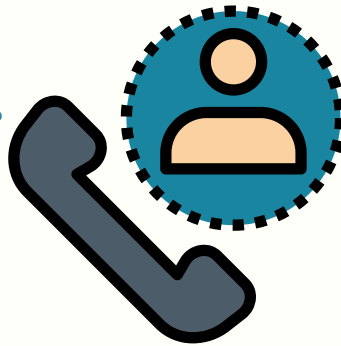
