- **Treasurer's report.** Gilda Gularte. Our beginning balance on May 17 was \$6,590. Our income was \$6,400, expenses were \$3,611, and our balance on July 18 was \$9,380. We are a PAC organization and can give donations to candidates. We need monthly donations to our Club to prepare for future elections. In the past we had voted to approve \$250 for general meeting supplies, and it is almost depleted. **Don Williamson moved and Bill Simon 2nd that we add \$300 to our meeting supplies. It passed unanimously.** PAC groups must report their expenses to the California Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) every 6 months. Our report for January through June is almost done
- **Central Committee.** Their fundraiser in Ontario raised about \$15,000
