Interpretation services are available from FSA. Ask for an interpreter if you are more comfortable receiving information in a language other than English.

If there is no CPA-026 already for the land, filling out the AD-1026 will start the process with NRCS to create one. **Provision exists for a person without land devoted to agriculture: for example, a honey producer who just owns the hives, or aquaculture that happens indoors. If that is your situation, be prepared to ask about this provision.
