Reimbursement Policy for RNLA Conferences and Seminars

The Republican National Lawyers Association (RNLA) has established the Bob Horn Fund for Law Students in honor of its Founding Chair Robert J. Horn, to encourage law students to be more active in RNLA. The Bob Horn Fund for Law Students will provide financial assistance to law students who wish to attend RNLA's annual National Policy Conference (NPC) and National Election Law Seminar (NELS) and assist in the establishment of law student chapters in key states throughout the country.

RNLA staff will have sole discretion to disburse funds from the Bob Horn Fund for Law Students.

RNLA has limited funds to assist law students with attending NPC and NELS. To be eligible to receive these funds, students must:

- Be enrolled in law school or have graduated within the past year.
- Be an active member of RNLA.
- Agree to volunteer to help ensure that elections are open, fair, and honest on Election Day or other days throughout the year.
- Waive RNLA's liability for injuries sustained while traveling to or from or attending NPC or NELS.

Preference will be given to students who:

- Are leaders in RNLA or the Republican Party.
- Are involved in or working to start an RNLA law student chapter.

REGISTRATION

All recipients of the Bob Horn Fund are entitled to free registration for NPC and NELS.

NON-VOLUNTEER RECIPIENTS

Non-volunteer recipients of the Bob Horn Fund are entitled to a reimbursement for travel funds. Travel funds will be disbursed on a case-by-case basis, not to exceed \$300. Submission of receipts is required to receive reimbursement.

VOLUNTEER RECIPIENTS

Recipients of the Bob Horn Fund who are also willing to volunteer for NPC or NELS will be eligible for reimbursement for travel and lodging or a lodging reimbursement. Submission of receipts is required to receive reimbursement.

- NPC: All-day volunteers are entitled to reimbursement for travel and lodging expenses, not to exceed \$600.
- NELS: Volunteers for the two-day Seminar are entitled to reimbursement for travel expenses, not to exceed \$300, and two nights of free lodging at the site of the Seminar.
