A **white, round pill** sold as **Percocet** was tested and contained **metonitazine**, a **high-potency synthetic opioid** considered to be **4 times stronger** than fentanyl.

- Using high-potency opioids increases the risk of overdose.
- Naloxone can reverse the effects of nitazine, but it may take more doses to revive someone.
- Pill was brought to Street Connections for testing on Dec. 19 and sent to Health Canada for confirmation.
