





What's Happening in Bethlehem this Christmas?

Maybe you should do something about it before celebrating.

December 12, 2023—Did you know that Christian churches in Bethlehem have cancelled Christmas celebrations? How many of your googly-eyed shopping friends and neighbors have stopped to consider that Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus Christ, is in the Israeli-occupied West Bank, and inhabited by Palestinian Christians, as well as Muslims?

The Christian leaders in Bethlehem are in mourning for the nearly 20,000 (as of this writing) Palestinian civilians who have been slaughtered by the American-armed Israeli Defense Forces since the Hamas terror attack in Israel on October 7.

Therefore, Christmas in Bethlehem will be a time of sorrow and silence, unless the people of the United States force our criminal and murderous Biden Administration to act to halt the slaughter.
