The Saskatchewan Higher Education Quality Assurance Board (SHEQAB) informed me about the concerns you raised by email on July 7, 2015, regarding Briercrest College and Seminary's approach regarding homosexuality and related issues.

I asked the SHEQAB to look into the issues you raised, and in January 2016, two Board members met with Briercrest officials, faculty and students. In its report to me, the SHEQAB indicated that Briercrest is taking steps to raise students' awareness about their rights and responsibilities with respect to harassment, to foster more open communication on campus regarding sexual preference issues, and to educate faculty and staff about relevant policies and practices. The Board made recommendations as to how Briercrest might enhance these efforts, and I have passed them onto the institution.

Thank you again for expressing your concerns and providing your insight on this matter. I wish you well and much success in your future endeavors.
