



WOMEN'S SAFETY AND FAMILY PROTECTION POLICY



WHAT WE BELIEVE

A woman is an adult human female.

Women deserve to be safe, respected, supported, and protected.

We believe that the rights of women and girls should never be sacrificed to ideology, political fashion, or bureaucratic convenience.

Women have the right to privacy, dignity, fairness, and equal opportunity.

They have the right to safe spaces, fair sporting competition, freedom of expression, and public policies that recognise biological reality.

We also recognise that women face unique challenges throughout pregnancy, childbirth, and motherhood. Too often, governments focus on expanding abortion while failing to provide the practical support that many women need to carry and raise a child.

A society that supports women does not force them to choose between their future and their child. It provides genuine support, real options, and practical assistance.

We believe every human life has value. We believe women deserve support during pregnancy, not abandonment. We believe children deserve protection and families deserve policies that help them thrive.

We reject the false choice between protecting women and protecting children. A compassionate society does both.



OUR ACTION PLAN

Protect Women's Spaces

- Legislate to protect female-only toilets, change rooms, refuges, hospital wards, correctional facilities, and other single-sex spaces.
- Provide legal certainty for organisations maintaining female-only facilities where privacy, dignity, safety, or vulnerability are legitimate concerns
- Ensure women and girls can access these spaces with confidence and without compromise.

Protect Women's Sport

- Require sporting competitions, representative teams, and female sporting categories to be based on biological sex.
- Protect fairness, safety, and equal opportunity for women and girls at all levels of sport.
- Support sporting organisations implementing sex-based participation policies.

Protect Women's Services

- Guarantee that women's refuges, crisis accommodation, support programs, counselling services, and health services established for women remain available to biological women.
- Ensure vulnerable women can access support services designed specifically for their needs.

Defend Freedom of Speech and Advocacy

- Protect the right of women, sporting bodies, community organisations, parents, and advocacy groups to speak about women's rights without fear of censorship, discrimination, harassment, or professional retaliation.



OUR ACTION PLAN - Continued

- Prevent government-funded bodies from restricting lawful public debate on issues affecting women and girls.

Expand Support for Women Facing Crisis Pregnancies

- Establish a dedicated Crisis Pregnancy Support Fund.
- Provide practical assistance including:
 - Emergency accommodation
 - Financial support
 - Parenting assistance
 - Counselling services
 - Pregnancy and infant supplies
 - Case management and referral services
- Ensure women facing difficult circumstances receive real support before, during, and after pregnancy.

Invest in Pregnancy Support Services

- Provide funding opportunities for eligible not-for-profit organisations that deliver practical support to women experiencing crisis or unplanned pregnancies.
- Expand access to services in regional and rural communities where support options are often limited.
- Focus funding on organisations delivering measurable outcomes for mothers and children.

Reform Adoption Laws

- Modernise adoption laws to reduce unnecessary bureaucracy and shorten waiting times.



OUR ACTION PLAN - Continued

- Expand support services for birth parents, adoptive families, and children.
- Promote adoption as a realistic and supported pathway for women unable to raise a child.

Protect Freedom of Conscience

- Restore and strengthen legal protections for doctors, nurses, midwives, pharmacists, and healthcare workers who object to abortion on moral, ethical, or religious grounds.
- Prevent discrimination against healthcare professionals exercising conscientious objection.

Protect Faith-Based Healthcare Providers

- Guarantee the right of faith-based hospitals and healthcare institutions to operate according to their values and beliefs.
- Prevent government funding penalties or regulatory coercion aimed at forcing participation in abortion services.

Ban Sex-Selective Abortion

- Introduce and support any legislation prohibiting abortion carried out solely on the basis of the sex of the child.
- Establish reporting and compliance measures to prevent discriminatory abortion practices.

Restrict Late-Term Abortion

- Introduce legislation prohibiting elective abortions after 22 weeks and 6 days gestation, except in narrowly defined medical circumstances.
- Require independent specialist review processes for any abortion

- Recognise the increasing viability and development of unborn children in late pregnancy.

Support Mothers and Families

- Expand access to maternal healthcare, postnatal services, parenting programs, and family support services.
- Improve access to maternity care in regional and rural communities
- Prioritise policies that strengthen families and reduce pressures that contribute to unwanted pregnancy, family breakdown, and child disadvantage.
