WHAT WE BELIEVE

OUR ACTION PLAN

These policies reject that false choice.

We will restore affordable energy, rebuild industry, and put Australian workers, families, and communities first using the resources we have, the technology we trust, and the common sense that has been missing from national leadership.

Put Australians Before Climate Ideology



End policies driven by alarmism, fear campaigns, and unrealistic “net zero” deadlines. Restore honest debate—no more silencing scientists, workers, or communities who question the current orthodoxy. Require full transparency around climate modelling, including uncertainty and failed predictions.

Slash Energy Costs and Restore Reliability

Immediately prioritise lowering power prices for households and businesses. Scrap policies that artificially drive-up electricity costs through forced transitions. End subsidies that distort the energy market and shift costs onto taxpayers.

Rebuild Australia’s Industrial Base

Stop the destruction of Australian manufacturing caused by high energy costs. Protect key industries—steel, aluminium, mining, agriculture—from climate-driven regulation. Reverse policies that force Australian jobs offshore.

Use Australia’s Natural Advantages

Fully utilise Australia’s abundant coal, gas and nuclear resources to deliver cheap, reliable power. Expand domestic energy production to ensure national self-sufficiency. Reject the idea that Australia should cripple its own economy while other nations continue to expand fossil fuel use.

Invest in Nuclear Power for the Future

Lift restrictions and fast-track the development of nuclear energy in Australia. Build a modern, reliable baseload energy system that supports industry and long-term growth. Position Australia as a global energy powerhouse using both traditional and advanced power generating technologies.



Scrap Punitive Carbon Policies

Abolish carbon taxes, emissions trading schemes, and hidden levies that increase the cost of living. End policies that punish Australians for everyday activities like driving, farming, and running a business. Ensure no new climate regulation is introduced without direct, measurable benefit to Australians.

Focus on Real Environmental Outcomes

Shift focus away from abstract emissions targets to practical environmental management. Invest in land care, water security, bushfire mitigation, and local environmental protection. Above all support farmers and regional communities as stewards of the land—not targets of regulation and liquidation.

Strengthen National Sovereignty

Reject international agreements that impose economic harm or undermine democratic control. Ensure all environmental policy is decided by Australians, for Australians. Refuse to export jobs, wealth, and sovereignty in the name of global climate targets.
