We believe biological women have the right to safety, fairness, and respect in every aspect of life. No woman or girl should feel that her dignity, privacy, or opportunities are being compromised.

Protections for women must be clear, practical, and enforceable. This includes ensuring that spaces, services, and opportunities are designed with safety, fairness, and common sense at their core.

Public policy must uphold fairness in areas such as sport, facilities, and services, while recognising the importance of maintaining both safety and equal opportunity, only biological women should compete in women's sport.

These issues must be approached with respect, balance, and a commitment to social cohesion. Australians expect practical solutions that protect individuals, reduce conflict, and uphold dignity for all.

We believe in policies that deliver real-world outcomes—ensuring women are safe, respected, and treated fairly, while maintaining a cohesive and respectful society.



OUR POLICIES

Safe Spaces

Biological women have the right to safe and private access to toilets, change rooms, and other single-sex facilities. Public spaces, events, and support services must be protected for the comfort and protection of biological women and girls.

Fairness in Sport

Women's sport must be fair, with competition based on biological sex only, to preserve integrity and opportunity.

No Sexual Activism

The rights of women and girls should not be undermined by activist driven policies that ignore biological reality and compromise biological women. Women should be free to speak up for their safety and rights without fear of harassment, violence, censorship, discrimination or litigation.
