## Timetable & Procedure for Motions and Constitutional Amendments

Any Full member of Sikhs for Labour whose membership was fully paid up at the Freeze Date is eligible to submit and vote on Motions and Constitutional Amendments.

### Freeze Date

The Freeze Date for this AGM is 23.59 on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

### Submitting Motions and Constitutional Amendments

Any Full Member of Sikhs for Labour whose membership was fully paid up at the Freeze Date is eligible to submit either one Motion or one Constitutional Amendment.

Motions may be on any topical issue and must not exceed 300 words in length.

Constitutional Amendments must clearly refer to which clause of the constitution is proposed to be amended and detail the amendment proposed and must not exceed 200 words.

The Constitution is attached at Appendix 3.

Motions and Constitutional Amendments must be submitted on the form provided and by the Closing Date for submitting Motions and Constitutional Amendments.

### Closing Date for Submitting Motions and Constitutional Amendments

All Motions and Constitutional Amendments must be received by 5pm on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

All Full members of Sikhs for Labour whose membership was fully paid up at the Freeze Date shall be entitled to vote on any Motions or Constitutional Amendments received.

Voting shall take place at the AGM.
