

**2023-7 Resolution Supporting Improvements at the Youth Services Center
Adopted April 20, 2023**

WHEREAS, the mission of the San Mateo County Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Commission (JJRPC) is to serve as the public conscience in the best interest of juveniles, advocate for programs and services that prevent youth incarceration, and uphold respect for the human dignity of all minors who enter the San Mateo County Juvenile Justice System; and

WHEREAS, the JJRPC undertakes an annual inspection of the Youth Services Center, which holds incarcerated youth, for whom the County has responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the 2021-2022 inspection report dated November 21, 2022 recommended common-sense improvements in areas such as food service, health and hygiene, mental health services, and vocational services and was unanimously adopted by the JDPCC on December 13, 2022;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Mateo County Democratic Central Committee supports the JJRPC recommendations and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Mateo County Democratic Central Committee urges the Board of Supervisors to adopt these JJRPC recommendations and asks the Probation Department to implement them.
