We will begin with the **South Shore Joint Initiative Annual General Meeting**, followed by a captivating special presentation from underwater explorer and filmmaker **Kenn Feigelman** on the legendary **Marysburgh Vortex**.

While the Bermuda Triangle captures global headlines, Prince Edward County has its own chilling counterpart. For centuries, sailors and lighthouse keepers have whispered about the treacherous currents and inexplicable compass failures within the Marysburgh Vortex. From vanished ships to missing aircraft, much of the history of these rugged shores remains undiscovered beneath the surface. Kenn will take us on a "deep dive" into these enduring stories and the mysterious energy that defines our local waters.
