# WHAT WE RECYCLE

## METAL CANS



Food and beverage cans

## GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS



Food and beverage containers

## PLASTIC BOTTLES, JUGS, TUBS



Beverage, butter, yogurt, whipped cream containers

## PAPER AND BOXES



Newspaper, magazines, mail, copy paper, corrugated cardboard, cardboard tubes, paper egg cartons, cereal boxes

## CARTONS



Milk, juice, wine, and broth boxes

## CLEAR PLASTIC FAST FOOD DRINK CUPS



Iced coffee/tea, cold beverages

## PAPER HOT DRINK CUPS



Coffee/tea.  
No lids.

### Program Guidelines:

- Recycle only the materials on the City's list.
- Material must be clean and not bagged.
- "When in doubt, throw it out". If you're not sure if something is recyclable, place it in the black trash cart.
- All materials for recycling must be inside the blue recycling cart (none outside of cart).
- Carts may be placed curbside for collection weekly, between noon the day before collection and 8AM on collection day.
- Carts must be brought back in before noon the day after collection.
- Do not mark, paint, or otherwise alter cart, except for applying stickers provided by the City.

# DON'T PUT THIS IN THE BLUE RECYCLING CART

**Do not put these items in the recycling cart. Check the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District's [CuyahogaRecycles.org](http://CuyahogaRecycles.org) webpage for alternative recycling programs and drop off locations.**

- Aluminum foil
- Batteries
- Tree branches
- Tires
- Shrubs
- Leaves
- Shredded paper
- Light strings
- Scrap metal
- Plastic bags
- Packing peanuts
- Clothing
- Computers
- Construction materials
- Grass clippings
- Household goods
- Styrofoam
- Plastic clamshell food containers
- Hoses cords and wires
- Ceramics
- Solo cups
- Plastic utensils
- Toys
- Other plastic goods not listed as accepted.

**Hazardous materials, light bulbs, medications, syringes and needles, propane tanks, non-empty aerosol cans, and latex paint require special handling and proper disposal. Do not put them in the recycling cart.**

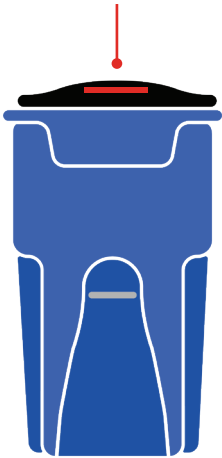

## CLEAN AND DRY YOUR BIN'S APPLICATION SITE PRIOR TO APPLYING STICKERS



**Top of Bin:**

Place your "Accepted Materials" sticker (**marked on the diagram in red**) on the lid of your bin, on the flat area just behind where you place your hand to open it.

### Left and Right Sides of Bin:

Place one "Recycle Cleveland" logo sticker (**marked on the diagram in yellow**) on each side of your bin, above the City of Cleveland logo.

**DO NOT COVER THE BIN'S SERIAL NUMBER  
WITH THE STICKERS.**
