Kirsty Boden Scholarships

What:

- Scholarships to help new migrants become patrolling Surf Life Savers at Tamarama Beach in Sydney.
- Up to \$1000 per scholar. Five scholarships are available.
- Scholarship covers: Tamarama SLSC Membership fees; pool fees; Bronze course (9 week course of Saturday mornings 8am-1pm and one intensive full weekend 8am-4pm); gear and equipment (swimwear, goggles and fins); travel costs to the club during your course; swimming lessons (capped at \$500) and/or a Senior First Aid course.

How: Scholars will be assisted to completing the Bronze Medallion, Surf Rescue certificate or Senior First Aid qualifications by providing equipment, support, and training for successful applicants.

Why: Tamarama wants to be a leading Surf Life Saving Club. We will do that by recruiting a broad range of people to the club, by training them well, including them into the Tamarama community, and by providing ongoing support and engagement. Central to this vision is being an inclusive club that welcomes new people, helps them thrive in the club, and keeps them involved in the club.

Who: New migrants who are interested in the beach and keeping people safe.
