Thank you for your email of 16 May 2025 in which you request the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

- "• All internal and external correspondence (including emails, briefing notes, call records, or reports) relating to the logistics, importation, quarantine, or diplomatic handling of the Mongolian horse gifted to Winston Peters.
- Any delays, complications, or issues raised by officials regarding the handling or transfer of the horse, including inter-agency communication (e.g. with MPI, Customs, MFAT, or the Mongolian government).
- Any cost incurred by New Zealand government agencies in relation to the transport, accommodation, quarantine, or care of the horse.
- The final outcome of the horse's handling including where it is currently located and whether it was officially accepted as a diplomatic gift."

In response to Part 1 of your request, the relevant documents are attached. Some information is withheld under the following sections of the OIA:

- 6(a): to avoid prejudicing the security or defence of New Zealand or the international relations of the New Zealand Government;
- 6(b)(i): to protect the passing of information from another government on a confidential basis;
- 9(2)(a): to protect individuals' privacy; and
- 9(2)(g)(i): to protect the free and frank expression of opinions by departments. Where the information has been withheld under section 9 of the OIA, no public interest in releasing the information has been identified that would override the reasons for withholding it.

Part 2 of your request is refused under 18(e) of the OIA, as the information requested does not exist.

Regarding parts 3 and 4 of your request, The Ministry can confirm that the horse was accepted as a gift of the Mongolian Government. It remains in Mongolia in the care of a local family at no cost to the New Zealand Government. The Mongolian Government can facilitate visits to the horse in future if requested by the New Zealand Government
