A quick bit of googling suggests this has precedent, but obviously a great honour:

"In recent years, politicians have employed the symbolic gifting of horses for diplomacy. Traditionally a sign of great respect, the gift of a horse is one of the most culturally significant ways to honor another individual in Mongolia. This unique approach has grabbed international headlines of news outlets, such as the New York Times, Reuters, and Foreign Policy. The practice was performed twice in 2019, with Donald Trump and US Defense Secretary Mark Esper."

BEI's proposal that the nomad family looks after the horse might not be a bad idea, but would obviously need to be squared away beforehand. We don't want to force a horse on them if it'll be inconvenient or costly. We could ask Erin to look into options on her arrival on Monday.

Inder the official information Act In some exciting news, the Mongolian Government will be gifting a **horse** to the Minister while he is in Mongolia. This is intended to be a surprise, and Post was advised in confidence. A few key points:

- Receiving a horse as a gift is a great honour. Other recent recipients include Secretary Blinken (2023) and Defence Secretary Esper (2019). John McKinnon was gifted a horse in 2004, named Skye (after the Isle of Skye)
- The handover is expected to take place during the nomadic lifestyle event with a Mongolian family on the morning of 28 Feb. The Day Pack for 28 Feb will be updated as we learn more about the arrangements from Mongolian officials.
- The Minister will not be expected to take the horse away. It will likely be presented as a gift, then remain in a paddock to be looked after by a Mongolian trainer.
- We understand that New Zealand will be expected to name the horse. We have suggested a few names below, though very much welcome the Minister's views:
 - Karaka: named after the North Island town/region known for annual yearling sales

- Silver Fern: named after an iconic New Zealand symbol
- Kaimanawa: named after the mountains home to New Zealand's wild horses
- [We could seek a Mongolian name based on the horse's appearance or characteristics]
