Registration and Training

- Please arrive at the Olympia Ballroom (116 Legion Way SE, Olympia, WA 98501) at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, Feb. 8 to register for the event. We will have hot breakfast and training beginning at 8:00 A.M.
- The training will include information about how to lobby legislators and an overview of the day. Please see the legislative agenda for our priorities with legislators.
- At 9:00 A.M., we will board buses to the Capitol Campus from the Olympia Ballroom. Buses will return to the Olympia Ballroom at 2:30 P.M. We recommend you leave your car near the Olympia Ballroom because parking at the Capitol Campus is limited.

Attire

- Please dress in business casual – a polo shirt and khakis or slacks is appropriate. Please refrain from wearing jeans and a t-shirt as we want to look professional for this event.
- Wear comfortable shoes as many of the buildings are marble and there is a lot of walking.
- Please check the weather. If there is rain in the forecast, bring a jacket or an umbrella.
