

We are excited you are joining us for our DOC Lobby Day in Olympia on February 7-8! **You will be lodging at the TownePlace Suites in Olympia.** Your point person for the event is **Joe Valadez**. Joe will provide you with your per diem. If you have a question, Joe can be reached at 206-794-2476. Please review all of the logistical information carefully so you know what to expect. More details below:

#### **Transportation**

- Your bus will depart **MCC-TRU on Wednesday, February 7 at 2:30 P.M** and travel to TownePlace Suites (900 Capitol Way S, Olympia).
- If you are driving yourself, please arrive at the hotel by 7:00 P.M. on February 7 to check in.

#### **Hotel**

- Your hotel is TownePlace Suites (900 Capitol Way S, Olympia). Check in any time after 3:00 P.M.
- The next morning, we will board buses at 7:15 A.M. and travel to the Olympia Ballroom (116 Legion Way SE, Olympia) where we will have a hot breakfast and training beginning at 8:00 A.M.
- Be sure to **check out of your hotel and board the bus by 7:15 A.M. with your luggage** as we will not be returning to the hotel.
- If you are driving, please **check out of the hotel** and plan to arrive at the Olympia Ballroom by 7:30 A.M. to register for the event.

#### **Registration and Training**

- Please arrive at the Olympia Ballroom at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, Feb. 8 to register. We will have hot breakfast and training beginning at 8:00 A.M.
- The training will include information about how to lobby legislators and an overview of the day. Please see the legislative agenda to view our priorities in conversations with legislators.
- At 9:00 A.M., we will board buses to the Capitol Campus from the Olympia Ballroom. Buses will return to the Olympia Ballroom at 2:30 P.M.
- If you drove, we recommend you leave your car near the Olympia Ballroom because parking on Capitol Campus is limited.

#### **Attire**

- Please dress in business casual – a polo shirt and khakis or slacks is appropriate. Please refrain from wearing jeans and a t-shirt as we want to look professional for this event.
- Wear comfortable shoes as many of the buildings are marble and there is a lot of walking.
- Please check the weather. If there is rain in the forecast, bring a jacket or an umbrella.

#### **Food**

- Members will receive a per diem for dinner (\$65 per individual and \$130 for members with guests) on February 7, which can be received from your point of contact. Members can have dinner at the location of their choice.
- Breakfast will be part of the training the following morning beginning promptly at 8:00 A.M.
- During Lobby Day, boxed lunches will be available in the Pritchard building on the Capitol Campus from 11:30 A.M.-1:00 P.M. set up at tables near the coffee stand.

#### **Appointments with Legislators**

- We've set up appointments between 10:00 A.M.- 2:00 P.M. with legislators in their offices.
- If we were not able to schedule an appointment, we will pull legislators from the floor / caucus.
