#### GENERAL OPERATING STATEMENT

This Utility Employee Change of Operations request, in conjunction with a filed Article 8, Section 6 Multi Region Change of Operations request will allow the operating companies to significantly improve its customer service product by establishing the thirty-five (35) Velocity Distribution Centers. Nine hundred ninety-eight (998) Utility Employee positions will be established at one hundred forty-four (144) Terminal locations, each within approximately one hundred seventy-five (175) mile radius of its described destination.

As identified by the Union and Management negotiators within the terms of Article 3, Section 7 of the National Master Freight Agreement, concerning the adoption of the Utility Employee Language, they stated and agreed: The parties recognize the need for the Employers to compete effectively in a changing environment. To this end, there shall be established a new position on the local cartage seniority list called a Utility Employee. The intent of the parties' creation of the Utility Employee position is to generate additional job opportunities and enhance employee earnings, by enhancing the Employer's ability to compete and grow.

Subject to the approval of the National Utility Employee Review Committee, the Employer may establish Utility Employee positions at any facility at its discretion as-needed, and CDL-qualified road or local cartage employees may bid for Utility Employee positions in accordance with established terminal bidding procedures. All CDL-qualified drivers with the required endorsements shall have the opportunity to transfer to the local cartage operation, if necessary, and bid for open Utility Employee positions with full seniority rights. There shall be no retreat rights for employees who transfer to the local cartage operation to bid an open Utility Employee position. For example, if a road driver bids into the Utility Employee position, he relinquishes his road seniority for bidding purposes and cannot return to the road driver classification, unless through a change of operations, or bid back rights consistent with the applicable Supplement. The Employer shall be permitted to assign a qualified local cartage employee to a Utility Employee position on a temporary basis when necessary to pursue business opportunities that become available, as long as the temporary assignment is made in seniority order and if senior employees do not accept the temporary positions, less senior employees are forced from the bottom of the seniority list. Temporary vacancies in the Utility Employee position, for things such as sickness, vacations, leaves of absences, will be filled consistent with practices under the applicable Supplemental Agreement.

The Utility Employee shall work across all classifications as assigned and as necessary to meet business needs, and there shall be no restrictions on the type of freight or work handled. A Utility Employee's duties during a tour of duty may, at his/her home terminal, include performing Utility-related dock work, P&D (local cartage) work, hostling/yard work (drop & hooks), and any driving work. At larger facilities where the Employer utilizes Utility Employees and there is more than Utility work performed, the Employer will designate a specific area on the dock where freight to be handled by Utility Employees will be staged. Non-utility freight will be staged at a designated area and the employees at the destination terminal will handle the non-utility freight.

A Utility Employee shall perform all local cartage functions at his home terminal. Notwithstanding anything in this Agreement or any Supplemental Agreement to the contrary, Utility Employees also may be required to work across Local Union jurisdictional lines. It is not the intent to use Utility Employees to perform local peddle runs or P&D work outside their Local Union's jurisdiction. At away terminals, a Utility Employee may perform Utility-related dock work, hostling and drop and hooks on his/her own equipment. A Utility Employee shall fuel his/her own equipment at away terminals, if there are no fuelers available. All Utility Employees shall be returned to his home domicile at the end of his shift, absent bona fide extenuating circumstances, in which case they shall be paid on all hours.

This Utility Employee Change of Operations will establish Utility Employees at the terminal facilities listed below and is being proposed in conjunction with the establishment of new Velocity Distribution Centers in MR-CO-03-11/2022. At these new Velocity Distribution Centers, the Utility-related dock work performed by Utility Employees will consist of handling transfer freight. Transfer freight is freight that is not originating from or destined for that Velocity Distribution Center's city operation, and includes freight brought in by means other than the Utility Employee. In the event a Utility Employee brings in city freight destined for that Velocity Distribution Center. It will be staged in a designated area. Freight that originates from that Velocity Distribution Center's city operation and is to be included in a Utility Employee's load likewise may be staged for handling by a Utility Employee. Utility Employees also will perform other duties as assigned in accordance with Article 3 Section 7 of the National Master Freight Agreement at both his/her home terminal and the designated Velocity Distribution Center.

This proposed Change of Operations is designed to enhance the Company's operations and create opportunities for business growth, which would create job opportunities across all classifications. The Company intends to support business growth related to the Velocity Distribution Centers by adding additional Local Cartage employees at those Velocity Distribution Centers, as well as additional Utility Employees. In the event business levels support the addition of Utility Employees beyond those provided for in this proposed Change of Operations, the Company will return to the Committee in accordance with Article 3, Section 7 of the National Master Freight Agreement. The Company will at the same time advise the Committee of the number of Local Cartage employees it plans to add at the new Velocity Distribution Centers.

The Company does not intend to use the Utility Employees provided for in this proposed Change of Operations to reduce the number of Local Cartage employees at the new Velocity Distribution Centers. If this proposed Change of Operations is approved, the number of Local Cartage positions in existence at the Velocity Distribution Centers on the date of implementation of this and the accompanying Article 8, Section 6 Change of Operation will be identified and provided to the Committee in writing on a red circle list by number. The Company will not reduce the red circle number of Local Cartage positions identified for each Velocity Distribution Center as a result of the use of Utility Employees. This proposed Change of Operations, in combination with the proposed 2022 Terminal Consolidation, Terminal Zip Code Realignment, Velocity Distribution Center & Road Network Realignment Change of Operations, will be comprised of the following Velocity Distribution Center locations.

#### **General Provisions**

The Utility Employee Change of Operations will create nine hundred ninety-eight (998) Utility Employee positions at one hundred forty-four (144) Terminals in accordance with Article 3 Section 7 of the National Master Freight Agreement.

2022 Terminal Consolidation, Terminal Zip Code Realignment, Velocity Distribution Center & Road Network Realignment Change of Operations must be implemented simultaneously and is part and parcel to Utility Employee Change of Operations which will have an effect on both road driver and local cartage positions. The Company will comply with the seniority application decision of the Committee; however, we would put forward the following job opportunity proposal for the National Utility Employee Review Committee and the Multi Region Change of Operations Committee's consideration:

- Bidding opportunities afforded in the 2022 Terminal Consolidation, Terminal Zip Code Realignment, Velocity Distribution Center & Road Network Realignment Change of Operations for the Road and Local Cartage classifications will be identified as "Pool" bid opportunities. Article 8 Section 6 and Article 3 Section 7 pool bid opportunities will be available simultaneously to the respective bidder during the telephone pool bid. For pool bidding participants, both active and inactive employees shall be afforded the opportunity to participate in the bidding, however, employees hired on or after the postmark date of mailing for this Change of Operations shall not be able to bid. The pool bid employees will be bid active to active and inactive to inactive.
- Any employee bidding a utility position must be CDL qualified at the time of the bid. Only those employees who are CDL qualified and have all of the required endorsements at the time of the bid will be permitted to bid.
- Terminals that are losing road and are gaining Utility Employee positions shall have the first opportunity to bid those gaining Utility Employee positions within the terminal based on the following:

#### SEPARATE LINE SENIORITY TERMINALS

- Terminal bid open to current road drivers only
- Any unfilled positions will be included in the pool bid
- Any remaining unfilled positions will be reposted at the specific terminal and made available to all qualified local cartage employees.
- The numbers to be bid shall be equal to or less than the number of positions lost. In no event will a location be permitted to bid more positions than it is losing. These bids will be posted and awarded at each location described above, prior to any pool bidding.
- At those gaining facilities where there are employees on letter of layoff who are senior to employees transferring in, the senior laid off employees may not exercise their seniority to bump the less senior employee transferring in unless and until such time as they are recalled by letter of recall or worked back on by the terms of their Supplement to fill regular available work opportunities, at which time they shall be dovetailed on the active seniority list, but will not be able to displace a less senior Utility Employee prior to six (6) months after implementation, after which the Utility Employee positions will be bid consistent with the

Local practice or consistent with the applicable Supplement. However, in the event of a layoff, employees will be laid off in seniority order.

When approved, the Company will post terminal bid sheets for Utility positions as indicated in Exhibit 1, for a period of seven (7) days and award these positions on the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) day. The Company will then post all unfilled and open positions - for pool bidding as described above.

The Company requests to implement the 2022 Terminal Consolidation, Terminal Zip Code Realignment, Velocity Distribution Center & Road Network Realignment Change of Operations and the Utility Employee Change of Operations to be determined.

Moving expenses in this Change of Operations will be handled in accordance with the provisions contained in Article 8, Section 6 of the National Master Freight Agreement.

The Company agrees that nothing in this proposed Change of Operations is intended to violate and/or alter the provisions of the NMFA or the applicable supplemental agreements.
