Pronunciation

Vowels Oropuare

There are five vowel sounds in Māori.
They can be pronounced 'short' or
'long'. The long vowel is marked with
a macron, e.g. ā.

a as in cup ā as in car
e as in set ē as in egg
i as in eat ī as in heel
o as in for ō as in your
u as in to ū as in roof

Where two different vowels appear
together they retain their basic
sound and run together.

Consonants Orokatī

There are 10 consonants, they are:
h, k, m, n, ng, p, r, t, w, wh.

ng as in winger, wh as in film
r is rolled as in udder or puddle.
