Motivation

Why are you running for *this* office?

I'm a fighter. Always have been. The Sunset is my home and my home needs a fighter. That's why I'm running for District 4 Supervisor to fight for my home. When PGE causes devastating blackouts that hurt Sunset small businesses and residents, I fought back by organizing my community and by filing a class action lawsuit against PGE. When thousands of Chinese and Asian American residents in the Sunset didn't have a political voice, I organized voter registration drives to add them to the voter rolls. When playgrounds, fields and facilities were in dire need of renovation and repair, I fought to get the necessary funds and resources to get them fixed. As a Supervisor, I will fight to make District 4 the best neighborhood in the City.

What are your values, and how did you get them?

My values were engrained in me at a very young age. I was born and raised in San Francisco and went to public schools in the City. My teachers, coaches and mentors instilled in me core values of selflessness, service, honor and duty which guide me to this day.

What communities do you represent, and how do they hold you accountable?

I represent the Asian American community and they hold me accountable because I am an active member of the community.

What are the top three issues you will work on, and what is your plan for achieving your goals?

1. I want to break up the monopolies like PG&E and Recology and lower our rates! I want to hold PG&E accountable. I want to bid out San Francisco's sole source garbage contract so that we can have competition drive down our rates and improve service. This can be accomplished by passing legislation at the Board of Supervisors and working with state partners. 2. I want to fix the broken infrastructure in my district including roads, lights, sewer pipes and other essential services. This can be done by working closely with department heads and the Mayor's office to identify and prioritize key projects for repair and replacement. 3. I want to build a police sub station so that we have better police coverage in District 4. This can be done by advocating for funding and building of a police substation.

How long have you lived in your supervisor district? If you have not lived in your district continuously, when is the most recent time you moved back to your district and why?

For 6 months now, my wife and I are planning to retire closer to our friends where majority of them live in the Sunset. My kids are adult and they moved out of the city, we wanted to downsize and also be closer to SFO.

How would you explain the biggest challenges your district faces?

The biggest challenges include high garbage and electricity rates which are making life difficult for fixed income seniors. Also the need to reopen the great highway to cars as we had during the compromise so that traffic congestion will be relieved. We have neglected infrastructure and playgrounds that need repair.

What do you feel are your district's biggest opportunities?

The Sunset has a great opportunity to become the best neighborhood in the city if I can repair the broken infrastructure, reopen the great highway to cars, break up the monopolies to lower rates and make people safer by building a police substation.

In what ways would your work as supervisor align with, or be different from, the last supervisor from this district?

I would reopen the great highway to cars. I oppose Mayor Lurie's family zoning plan and will fight to protect rent controlled housing stock from demolition to make way for market rate housing.

Do you support getting rid of district elections for the Board of Supervisors? Why or why not?

No. District elections have allowed for neighborhoods to have a greater say at City Hall.

Which specific city services do you feel should be protected from budget cuts, but have not been?

All city services need to undergo review and cuts where needed. I want to save essential services

Please describe your familiarity with the City Charter. Please give specific examples of what you would change in the charter, and what you think is important to preserve.

I am very familiar with the City Charter. I am not considering any changes to the charter at this time.

Please describe your familiarity with the Board of Supervisors budget process. How would you approach the City's budget? What would you prioritize? How would you ensure community voices are represented?

I am very familiar with the Board of Supervisors Budget process having served as a SF Recreation and Park Commissioner for over 7 years. I would prioritize front line staff and cut management. In my opinion we have a top management heavy city government. I would reallocate savings to the front line services.

Under what circumstances do you think it's appropriate for the Board of Supervisors to delegate its oversight function to the Mayor?

I do not think the Board of Supervisors should ever delegate oversight to the mayor. The BOS is supposed to be an independent oversight body and should not be abandoning that key function.

How did you vote or would you have voted on Mayor Lurie’s Family Zoning Plan? How would you explain your position to your constituents?

I would vote against Mayor Lurie’s family zoning plan. I would tell constituents the FZP would open up our neighborhood for rampant market rate housing development at the expense of affordable housing and without protections for rent controlled properties.

Whose voices are not being heard at City Hall? What new voices would you bring in to City Hall?

Immigrant voices are not being heard at City Hall. I would fight to bring immigrant voices to City Hall.

Did you join educators at the UESF picket line during the strike? Which school site did you go to, when, and why?

Yes, I went to Lowell High School. I was there because I support public educators and I'm one of them. My social media Intern is also attending Lowell High School and I got to meet and support her teachers
