Do you support more containers being accepted in the NSW container deposit scheme?

Strongly agree

It is being proposed that we include all beverage containers (non alcoholic and alcoholic) between 150ml and 3 litres, except for plain milk and registered health tonics. Do you support the proposed containers that would be included in an expanded scope?
